# History

Bentley Miniature Railway was originally formed in 1985 in the grounds of Bentley Wildfowl & Motor Museum, situated between Uckfield and Lewes. It started as a 250 yard circle of track based around, what is now, Bentley Central Station. In 1995 the track was extended to around half a mile (both 5" and 7¼" gauge) incorporating a new station, Glyndebourne Wood Halt.

The Railway celebrated its Silver Jubilee in 2010 and, to mark this milestone, planning commenced for a further extension of 7¼" gauge track to bring the total length to 1 mile. Once planning permission was granted construction commenced and the extended track opened fully at Easter 2012 with a third station (Bentley East) serving the wildfowl reserve.

Bentley Miniature Railway provides passenger rides to Bentley's visitors at weekends and Bank Holidays throughout the year. We also operate daily services during most East Sussex School Holidays.

A variety of steam and non-steam locomotives to standard and narrow gauge profiles, mostly owned by members, haul passenger trains on this, one of Britain's Great Little Railways.
